Log In and Enroll

1. To enroll, visit www.BattelleforKids.org/Tennessee to access the Tennessee Student Progress Portal.
2. On the portal home page, select the “My Portal” tab.
3. If this is your first time logging in, select “create a new account,” enter your respective school e-mail address and the access code. Returning users should enter your respective school e-mail address and password.

4. Once you log in, you will be presented with an overview of learning paths and suggestions for enrollment.
